The purpose of this assignment is to demonstrate how HTML (HyperText Markup Language) can be used to present elements of a document to a viewer. The basic elements to be demonstrated include: titles; headings (of chapters and sections); paragraphs; words in bold, italics, and underlined; special characters; line breaks; and horizontal rules. Using whatever content you like, write a web document that demonstrates as many of the formatting elements above using HTML.

Do not print out your formatted document, but rather post it to your personal website (www.msoe.edu/~username/index.html) where it can be viewed by myself, and anyone else for that matter. Obviously, replace the 'username' in the web address above with your logon ID to defiant.msoe.edu (MSOE's official web server). Remember, you'll need to download and install the Secure SHell (SSH) File Transfer Program from the course web page (www.msoe.edu/~blessing/ms273) in order to move files up to the web server for viewing.
