Cascaded Style Sheets

The purpose of this assignment is to demonstrate your understanding and capabilities with using Cascaded Style Sheets (CSS). Take an already developed web page (for instance, use one of the earlier assignments for this class) and modify its style using CSS formatting statements. Start with the basics, like fonts and text color. From there move on to more interesting style elements that can be applied to different parts of your web layout. For example, take a look at the “3 frames” example posted on this web site. In it you’ll see that each frame is styled differently, using links to three different CSS files. This design approach can be used to control an entire appearance of a web site. Design your own 3 frame layout in a way in which style can be controlled separately from the content of your pages.
