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**INDICTMENT**

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**COUNT ONE**

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

1. Between on or about November 1, 2004 and December 17, 2004, in the State and Eastern District of Wisconsin,

**FIELD C. HADLEY, and  
HENRY B. LEAL,**

the defendants herein, knowingly and intentionally manufactured marijuana, a Schedule I controlled substance.

2. The offense involved 100 or more marijuana plants.

All in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1), 841(b)(1)(B) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

**NOTICE OF FORFEITURE**  
**21 U.S.C. § 853(a)**

Pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, § 853(a) all right, title and interest of defendant Field C. Hadley in any and all property, real and personal, constituting, or derived from, any proceeds obtained directly or indirectly, as the result of the offense alleged herein, and any and all property, real and personal, used, or intended to be used, in any manner or part, to commit, or to facilitate the commission of the offense, is forfeited to the United States. These properties include the following:

- real property commonly known as 1424 Liberty Street, Oshkosh, Wisconsin;
- A personal money judgement in the amount of \$300,000 representing the unseized proceeds of the violation charged.

Pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(p) the defendant shall forfeit substitute property, up to the value described in the preceding paragraph, if by any act or omission of the defendant, the property described in the preceding paragraph, or any portion thereof, cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence; has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third party; has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the court; has been substantially diminished in value; or has been commingled with other property that cannot be subdivided without difficulty.
